PARKS WORKER - STUDENT

Nature and Scope

Reporting to the Director of Engineering, under the close supervision of the Parks Supervisor, the Parks Worker - Student performs duties related to the maintenance of municipal parks including preparing and maintaining gardens, playing fields, trees and grass areas.

Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Removes weeds and debris; waters, fertilizes, seeds, cultivates and prunes as required; maintains various annual and perennial plants; installs or removes turf, soil and top dressing.
- 2. Assists with the installation of irrigation systems and benches; completes various painting; picks up and disposes of refuse.
- 3. Operates push mowers, weed eaters and back pack blowers.
- 4. Operates and maintains various hand and power tools such as secateurs, hand saws, shovels, rakes, leaf blowers, line trimmers, and gas shears.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- 1. Work independently and as a part of a team;
- 2. Lift and move heavy materials and equipment;
- 3. Operate manual and power tools and equipment;
- 4. Understand and apply a variety of horticultural and garden maintenance techniques.

Required Qualifications

- 1. Grade 12 education or equivalent;
- 2. Valid Class 5 BC Driver's License.
