## -UPDATE-

CRD Integrated Water Services will be replacing their water main on Admirals Road from Maplebank Road (just north of the Esquimalt municipal border) to the Island Highway/Craigflower Road intersection in View Royal starting in December 2016. The project is scheduled for completion by March 2017.

Please be advised that Capital City Paving will be paving the new water main trench on Admirals Road, from Maplebank Road in Esquimalt to Hallowell Road, from Tuesday, February $14^{\text {th }}, 2017$ to Thursday, February $16^{\text {th }}$, 2017, during the daytime hours of 9:00AM to 3:00PM. Single lane traffic will be in effect along Admirals Road through the paving area.

Also, from Tuesday, February $14^{\text {th }}$, 2017 to Friday, February $17^{\text {th }}$, 2017, CRD Water crews will be installing the new water main between Aldersmith Place and Hallowell Road during the daytime hours of 9:00AM to 3:00PM. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained along Admirals Road through the construction area.

Nighttime water main work will take place on Tuesday, February $14^{\text {th }}, 2017$ at Admirals Road and Lekwammen Drive during the hours of 7:00PM to 6:00AM. Single lane traffic will be in effect.

Nighttime work will also take place on Thursday, February $16^{\text {th }}$, 2017 at Admirals Road and Hallowell Road during the hours of 7:00PM to 6:00AM. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained along Admirals Road through this construction area.

Traffic Control Persons will be situated in, and in advance of, the work zone to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.
