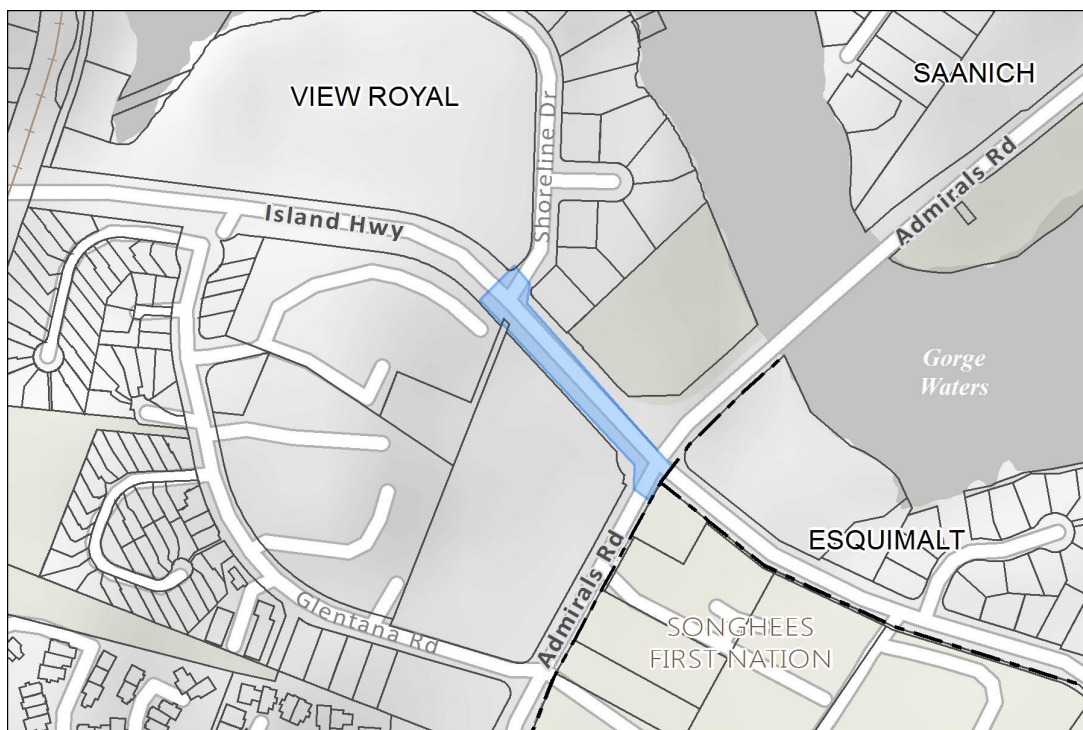


Water Main Upgrade Notice to Residents and Businesses: Island Highway

Beginning Sunday, August 12, 2018, CRD construction crews will begin the improvements on existing water main on Island Highway from Shoreline Drive to Admirals Road. This project will take approximately five (5) days to complete. Construction will take place between 7pm and 7am.

Construction noise and temporary traffic delays can be expected during regular working hours throughout this time. Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist traffic through the construction zone.

	<p><u>Work Hours:</u> Work will take place from 7pm to 7am.</p>
	<p><u>Road and Sidewalk Access:</u> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the construction work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><u>Driveway Access:</u> The CRD will notify you of any temporary restrictions to driveway access.</p>
	<p><u>Traffic Management:</u> Traffic control personnel will be on site to assist traffic through the construction zone for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should</p>
	<p><u>Parking:</u> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects the construction work,</p>
	<p><u>Water Service Interruptions:</u> Residents will be notified in advance of all scheduled water shut downs, but temporary shut downs may occur without warning.</p>
	<p><u>Restoration:</u> The construction work area will be restored with sod and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are</p>
