NOTICE OF PROCESSING AN APPLICATION FOR A NATURAL WATERCOURSE AND SHORELINE ENVIRONMENTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT WITH VARIANCES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an application for a Natural Watercourse and Shoreline Environmental Development Permit with variances is being considered for the property at **275 Kerwood** as shown boldly outlined on the map on the reverse side of this Notice. The affected lot is legally described as:

LOT A BLOCK 12 SECTION 27 ESQUIMALT DISTRICT PLAN EPP92154

Development Permit 2021/05 addresses the following variances within Zoning Bylaw No. 900, 2014:

- Variance to Section 3.8.2.a. the prohibition on retaining wall constructed within the setback from the natural boundary to the sea.
- Variance to Section 3.8.2.b, the setback for the boathouse, ramp and float structures from 15m to 0m.
- Variance to Section 4.8.9 the maximum height of a retaining wall from 1.2m to 1.52m.

The development proposal will be considered by the **View Royal Town Council on Tuesday, April 6, 2021 at 7:00 pm** and may by resolution:

- (a) authorize the issuance of the Development Permit;
- (b) authorize the issuance of the Development Permit as amended by Council in its resolution;
- (c) defer consideration of the Development Permit to a future date; or
- (d) refuse to authorize a Development Permit for the current proposal
