

NOTICE OF SERVICE DELAYS

Garbage & Kitchen Scraps Curbside Collection Program

January 05, 2022

Please be advised that due to ongoing weather and road conditions across the CRD, difficulty accessing Hartland Landfill, and vehicle malfunctions, the regular weekly Garbage & Kitchen Scraps collection schedule is experiencing delays.

The Town of View Royal's solid waste collection contractor, Waste Management, is working to catch up on addresses missed during the week of December 27th and will be providing service updates as conditions improve.

Please check the Town's website (<u>www.viewroyal.ca</u>) regularly for the most up-to-date collection service updates.

If your regular collection day is Tuesday:

- Waste Management completed 33% of its Tuesday route, and will be prioritizing remaining addresses today (Wednesday, January 5th)
- Please bring your totes and any additional bags of refuse out to curbside until it is collected this week
- If you have additional waste, you may leave out extra bags at no cost

If your regular collection day is Wednesday:

 Your Garbage and Kitchen Scraps may not be collected as scheduled today as Waste Management catches up with addresses missed last week

If your regular collection day is Thursday:

 Please place your totes and any extra bags at curbside on Thursday morning for regular pickup

If your regular collection day is Friday:

- Waste Management was able to collect garbage from many addresses on its Friday route last week, but kitchen scraps were missed for all addresses
- Addresses that missed both Garbage & Kitchen Scraps collection last week:

- Hallowell, Aldersmith, Glentana, Falstaff, Amber, Watkiss, Highbank, Seahaven, Avanti, St Giles, Six Mile Rd, Talcott, Island Hwy and Fenton
- Please place your totes and any extra bags at curbside on Friday morning for regular pickup
