Public Notice is given to the electors of the Town of View Royal that a general local election will be held on **Saturday, October 17, 2026**. Nominations for the office of:

Mayor (*one to be elected*)

Councillor (*six to be elected*)

for a four-year term will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person as follows:

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- eighteen (18) years of age or older on general voting day (October 17, 2026);
- resident of British Columbia for at least six (6) months (March 11, 2026) immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

- Office of Mayor \$15,768.28
- Office of Councillor \$ 7,884.14

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local election, the following third party advertising limits apply:

- Office of Councillor \$924.28
