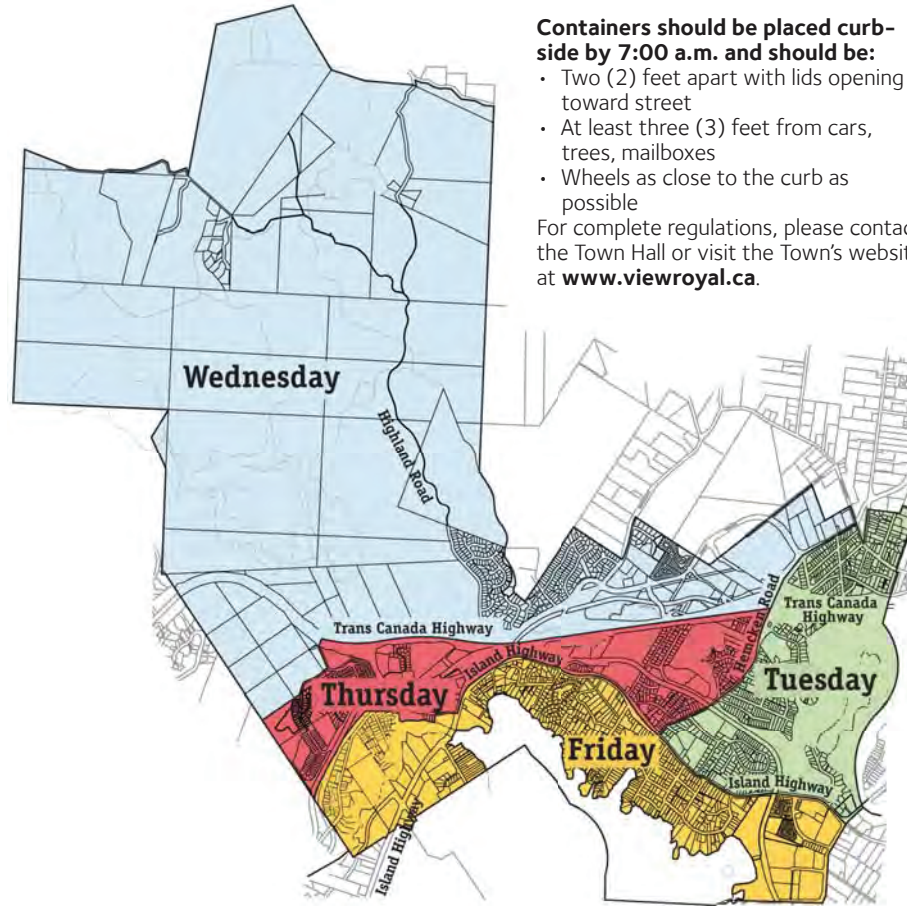

## Residential Garbage and Organics Collection In View Royal



### Waste Management provides the residential garbage and organics collection for View Royal residents.

Garbage and organics (kitchen scraps) are collected in separate Town-supplied totes that are emptied by a truck using automated arms. Collection regulations for residents are detailed in Town of View Royal Bylaw No. 745, 2009. A set of totes is automatically delivered to new homes upon occupancy permit issuance.

An annual charge for this collection is added to your property tax notice as a separate line item to be paid in conjunction with your residential property taxes.

# Organics (Kitchen Scraps) Guidelines

## YES

- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Food leftovers, plate scrapings
- Meat, fish, giblets and bones
- Dairy products, butter, mayonnaise
- Eggshells
- Bread, cereal, grains
- Pasta, pizza
- Baked goods, candies
- Soiled paper towels and tissues
- Soiled paper food packaging
- Used paper cups and plates
- Flour and sugar bags
- Coffee filters and grounds
- Tea bags
- Solidified fat and grease
- Baking ingredients, herbs, spices
- Houseplants, cut and dried flowers
- Nuts and shells

**NOTE: BPI Certified Compostable Bags** are required for the organics (kitchen scraps) collection. They must meet ASTM D6400 Standard Specifications for Compostable Plastics. Paper bags are also acceptable.

Please put your organics tote out every week, regardless of the amount of waste it contains.

Please keep the inside of your tote clean.

You can use old newspaper to line your tote or to wrap wet food waste.

**As of January 2015, kitchen scraps are banned as garbage at the Hartland Landfill. Kitchen scraps are not allowed in your garbage tote.**



# Garbage Guidelines

- Plastic bags and overwrap
- Plastic foam packaging
- All electronics, appliances
- Batteries
- Hazardous waste
- Medical waste or syringes
- Solvents, motor oil
- Concrete, rocks, soil, asphalt
- Liquids
- Fluorescent bulbs or tubes
- Drywall
- Scrap metal
- Paint

**Weight Limit:** 40 kg or 88 lbs

**Extra Garbage:** Garbage that exceeds the one allowed tote per week must be bagged and have an Extra Bag Decal attached to each additional bag. Decals can be purchased at the Town Hall.

# Lawn and Garden Waste

Lawn and garden waste is collected once per year in the fall on Saturdays at the curbside. See the coloured leaves on the calendars for your scheduled Saturdays.

Only these lawn and garden materials are accepted:

- Grass, leaves, flowers, shrub clippings and weeds** in recyclable brown paper yard waste bags (weight limit 35 lbs per bag). Please shake off any extra soil from flowers and weeds to reduce weight. Note that invasive plants, such as Scotch Broom, English Ivy and Himalayan Blackberry are not allowed in this service. They are allowed at the Hartland Landfill and

can be included in your weekly garbage.

- Bundled branches** (branch size limit 3 in. thick; 3 ft. long; bundle size 35 lb limit).

**Up to five** of the above bags or bundles in total will be collected per dwelling unit. An Extra Bag Decal must be attached to each additional bag or bundle over this limit. Decals can be purchased at the Town Hall.
