c) Strengthening Tree Protection Bylaw in New Developments

The Committee discussed the Town's Tree Protection Bylaw, specifically:

- expanding the focus of the bylaw to include greenspace between buildings;
- building setbacks;
- ability of a variety of trees providing shade;
- terms of reference;
- restricting intensity of construction blasting; and
- improved shoring methods.

The Director of Engineering noted the Urban Forest Strategy will be established with consultation from the Parks, Recreation & Environment Advisory Committee.
