PURPOSE: To establish a policy for the presentation of an award to recognize

individuals or local organizations for going above and beyond on

initiatives of community pride and accomplishments.

POLICY:

- 1.0 To qualify for presentation of this award a person must be a resident of the Town of View Royal and have made a significant contribution toward the community and/or municipality or brought credit and admiration to the Town. In exceptional circumstances, other persons may be recognized. The Mayor will receive nominations from the community and other Council members.
 - 1.1. A certificate and medal shall be awarded to the person by the Mayor at a regular or special Council meeting.
 - 1.2. The determination of this award is at the discretion of the Mayor with input from Council.
 - 1.3. A limit of twelve (12) awards may be made each year by the Mayor, preferably on a monthly basis; however in exceptional circumstances the Mayor, on the advice of Council, may make extra awards.
 - 1.4. Individuals recognized shall be contacted informing them of the award and request acknowledgement of acceptance.
 - 1.5. The recipients of the year will be invited to attend the annual Volunteer Recognition Dinner.
