VICTORIA FAMILY COURT & YOUTH JUSTICE COMMITTEE CITIZEN REPRESENTATIVE

Interested View Royal residents are invited to apply to serve as the Town's citizen representative (alternate) on the Capital Regional District's (CRD) Victoria Family Court & Youth Justice Committee to December 31, 2025.

The Committee educates and advocates for options to address the challenges and shortfalls facing youth and families who may come into contact with the justice system, supervises a small granting budget, and facilitates connections between local governments, school districts, service providers, and the broader community.

Applications are being accepted for one (1) citizen representative. The areas of competence typically sought on the Committee are:

- Legal experience, specifically youth criminal and family expertise
- Education, Health, Probation, and Welfare expertise, including those with backgrounds in social outreach programs, restorative justice, youth intervention, and child protective services

This is a working Committee and members volunteer time between regular meetings to participate in one or more sub-committees or initiatives. Committee members are not remunerated in keeping with the *Provincial Court Act*.

All volunteers must register with the CRD's Risk and Insurance Department and must, if working with vulnerable persons or persons under 18 years of age, provide a recent criminal record check to the CRD.

The Committee meets from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. on the fourth Thursday of each month, except for March, July, August, and December. Meetings are held at the Capital Regional District Board Room, 625 Fisgard Street with virtual attendance an option. Additional information regarding the Committee can be found [here](#).
