Reporting to the Director of Engineering, under the close supervision of the Deputy Director of Engineering, the Engineering Intern collects field data inventory using GPS, monitors and completes condition assessments for maintenance of Town infrastructure, assists with field or office projects and Engineering investigations, scans and files Engineering drawings and documents, and works with the Engineering Technologist to integrate GPS information into the existing GIS platform.

The ideal candidate for this position will be highly motivated with experience with ArcGIS; mapping grade GPS would also be beneficial.

In addition, the following qualifications are required:

- Completion of Grade 12 or equivalent;
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence;
- Current enrollment in an Engineering program at a recognized post-secondary institution - a Civil Engineering Program being an asset.
