ENGINEERING INTERN

Duties and Responsibilities:

Reporting to the Director of Engineering, under the close supervision of the Deputy Director of Engineering, the Engineering Intern:

- 1. Collects field data inventory such as roads, culverts, signs, streetlights and park equipment using GPS;
- 2. Monitors and completes condition assessments for maintenance of Town infrastructure;
- 3. Conducts field data collection for pedestrian, cyclist and traffic flows;
- 4. Works with the Engineering Technologist to integrate GPS information into the existing GIS platform;
- 5. Scans and files Engineering drawings and documents;
- 6. Assists with field or office projects and Engineering investigations as required;
- 7. Performs other related duties as assigned.
