### View Royal Public Alert Notification System (PANS)

In the case of a public safety incident, the Public Alert Notification System will be used to deliver critical and potentially life-saving alerts to residents who have registered.

Sign up today to receive public safety alerts – it only takes a few minutes! To register:

2. Create a user name and password
3. Provide at least one communication device and a valid civic (physical) address within View Royal. Note: please indicate in the registration that your “City” is “View Royal”

### 2019 Property Taxes

The 2019 property tax notices are mailed out to property owners in the last week of May.

Property taxes are due **Tuesday, July 2, 2019**. As of 12:01am, July 3, 2019, any unpaid 2019 property taxes or unclaimed 2019 Home Owner Grants will have a 10% penalty added to the outstanding balance.

There are many payment options available: in person or the drop box at Town Hall, mail, and online or telephone banking. The Town also has a program for property owners to pre-pay their annual property taxes.
