2019 Property Taxes

Property taxes are due **Tuesday, July 2, 2019**. As of 12:01am, July 3, 2019, any unpaid 2019 property taxes or unclaimed 2019 Home Owner Grants will have a 10% penalty added to the outstanding balance.

Payment Options:

- In person at Town Hall: 45 View Royal Ave, Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
- Payment Drop Box: located by the front doors of Town Hall. Post dated cheques and completed HOG forms can be dropped off 24 hours a day. Please indicate if you wish to receive a receipt.
- By Mail: 45 View Royal Ave, Victoria BC, V9B 1A6. Must be received at Town Hall by July 2, 2019.
- Internet or Telephone Banking: the vendor name is View Royal (Town of) Tax. Your account number will be the last eight digits of your property tax roll number (do not include the 401 or 402 or the decimal).



Accepted Payment Methods: Cheques, Cash and Debit Cards. If paying by Debit Card, you may be required to increase your daily security limit through your bank. Post dated cheques for July 2, 2019 are accepted. The Town of View Royal does not accept credit card payments, wire transfers or third party cheques.

Home Owner Grant (HOG): Don't forget to claim your HOG. Unclaimed HOG's will receive a 10% penalty as at 12:01 am on July 3, 2019.

- Claim your grant online by going to the website at www.viewroyal.ca; OR
- The HOG form is the detachable bottom portion of your tax notice. Completed forms can be dropped off at Town Hall in person or by using the after hours drop box located by the front doors or mailed in.

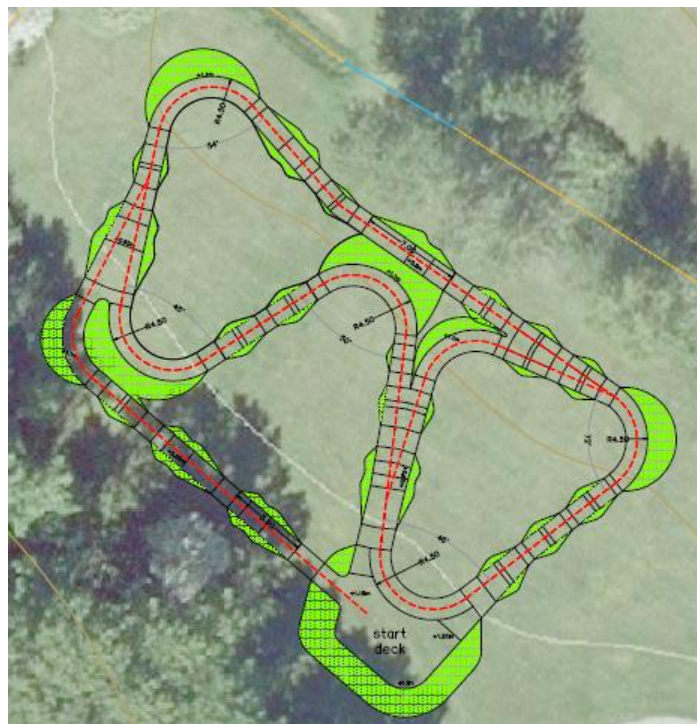

New Bike Park in View Royal Park Moves Forward

On Tuesday, June 11, the Committee of the Whole recommended that Council give the green light for staff to begin construction of "Concept B" for the new Bike Pump Track in View Royal Park.

To help choose the best track concept for the Town, staff created a track committee consisting of several volunteers including the bike park manager, a Team BC mountain bike coach, and a professional bike rider. The track committee agreed that a paved track with a "Concept B" design would work best for the new bike park. New Bike Pump Track - Concept B:



Construction of the new bike park is expected to begin in late June/early July and is anticipated to be completed by the end of July 2019.
