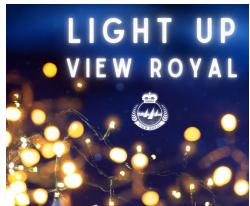

Snow & Ice Clearing Reminders – Sidewalks & Roads

The Town of View Royal's Engineering Department would like to remind residents to be prepared for the snow and inclement weather this winter season.

- Property owners must clear snow and ice from sidewalks adjacent to their property (see Streets Bylaw No. 980, 2019). Be sure to arrange for help in advance if you plan to be away from your home or if you require assistance with snow and ice removal. We ask that you kindly help your elderly or handicapped neighbours who may need assistance with snow removal.
- The Town will make every effort to keep intersections, high-use bus stops and crosswalks clear of snow and ice.
- Roads are cleared in the following order:

 1st Priority = Major Roads

 2nd Priority = Steep Hills

 3rd Priority = Collectors, School and Playground Zones
 Lowest Priority = Local Roads
- During prolonged snowfall, crews may need to continue maintaining higher priority roads before attempting lower priority ones.
- In the event of snowfall, please do not park on the roadway in order to ensure snowclearing equipment can navigate the streets safely. Owners of vehicles parked on the roadway can be subject to fines and/or towed away at the owner's expense.
- When clearing snow in your driveway or private road, be sure to pile the snow to the left hand side (facing your home) so the snow plow does not plow excess snow across your driveway or private road access.
- Please note that in the event of a heavy snowstorm or icy road conditions, our garbage collection contractor, Waste Management, may not be able to service certain customers due to safety or access reasons. Waste Management will collect any missed garbage as soon as they can safely do so. Please provide clear and safe access to garbage totes to ensure uninterrupted service.

Changes to Residential Curbside Blue Box Recycling Service

A message from CRD Recycling

Effective January 2, 2024, GFL Environmental Incorporated (GFL) will begin delivering the Capital Regional District's (CRD) curbside blue box collection program which provides recycling collection services to 132,000 single family homes in the region.

The CRD issued the six-year contract to GFL in October 2022, 15 months prior to service beginning, to allow for the time necessary to procure, manufacture and deliver the collection vehicles and ensure a smooth transition from the current service provider.

While accepted materials remain the same, some scheduled collection days may change. Residents impacted by route changes will be notified directly.

"We are committed to environmental sustainability and providing efficient waste management solutions," said Russ Smith, Senior Manager, CRD Environmental Resource Management, "This new contract offers increased collection capacity to reliably service the region, including future growth."

The contract includes the requirement to use low or zero-emission vehicles for collection. The 25-vehicle vehicle fleet includes 23 trucks fueled by compressed natural gas (CNG) and two electric-powered trucks.

Residents are advised that glass pick up will not be available between January 2 – February 1 due to labour disruption impacts.

The CRD is paid a fee to oversee the curbside blue box collection program by Recycle BC, a non-profit stewardship organization that represents producers of packaging and paper products in BC. Residents are not charged for this service. The BC Recycling Regulation requires producers of packaging and paper products in BC to be responsible for the recycling costs associated with the material, not residential taxpayers.



Residents in the region who receive curbside blue box collection are advised to visit www.crd.bc.ca/bluebox to access their curbside collection schedule and download the Recycling CRD app. Apart from Christmas and New Years days, collection proceeds as usual on holidays.
