What is FireSmart?

FireSmart is a provincial program committed to reducing the negative impacts of wildfire. The program is based on scientific research that shows doing simple tasks around where you live can make your property more resilient to wildfire.

View Royal FireSmart Program

Through the View Royal FireSmart program, residents can request a free Home Ignition Zone assessment to assess their home's risk from wildfire and receive recommended changes to help defend against structure ignition.
