

Notice of Westshore Alert System Testing

The View Royal Emergency Management Program will be testing the Westshore Alert public notification system on Monday, May 6, 2024 at 1:00pm.

Only members of the public who have subscribed to the Westshore Alert public notification system will receive the test alert.

About Westshore Alert

In the case of a public safety incident, the Westshore Alert public notification system will be used to deliver critical and potentially life-saving alerts to residents who have registered. This information can help you and your family know what to do, where to go, and what to expect.



Sign up to receive critical alerts for major emergencies and disasters (ie. tsunami, earthquake, wildfire) and/or lower severity alerts (ie. traffic, weather). You can also choose to receive notifications for more than one location such as your home, office, cottage, family, friends, etc.

If you live, work, or play in the Westshore, you are invited to register. Signing up is free, easy and can be done from your mobile phone, tablet, or computer.

Learn about the difference between soil structure and texture, what the cation exchange capacity of soil means, and so much more!
